## Principal's Report

Staffing updates: still in need of a $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade teacher (Ms. Sally is moving) and a band teacher (retiring).

We have been given 15 additional sets for Reader's and Writer's Workshop from Nina Otero school.

Schedules will be available on Power School before the start of the next school year.

Treasurer's Report

The Panther Run netted about $\$ 30,000, \$ 5000$ more than budgeted and about $\$ 10,000$ more than in the past. We received the same level of donations from the community and had much better sign up on the Get Movin' Crew site, but with far fewer expenses. A huge success!

## Presentation and Vote on 2019-2020 Budget

The budget is balanced, made with input by Ms. Jeffery, \& very similar to last year's, with a few decreased expenses. There is general agreement that we would like to maintain a year and a half of the budget in reserve.

The budget was approved by unanimous vote.

## Brick Discussion

Earlier this year, we moved to an online brick ordering system and 6 bricks were installed. These were not engraved, but printed instead, and durability is in question.

Vote passed to remake all printed bricks with engraving (6), which will cost approximately $\$ 150$.

Kinney's in Albuquerque engraves and will deliver. It is best to submit a group of orders all at once on an Excel file. It is also essential to measure the space for the brick in advance to ensure good fit.

## Secretary Gift

A gift card of $\$ 500$ was approved by majority vote for Hannah Wetovsky.

Mary Olson mentioned that the children need a snack/run-around transition time before after-school programs begin. Mara Raden suggested that the PTC offer the snack. Donations for clubs could go to this expense.

Snowflake parents will not be available next year, but Mary Granzow will continue to help. If replacements can be found, Rachel would take on after-school coordinator position.

## Actions to be taken:

Denise will ask Sharman if she is interested in heading the snowflake drive.

If Rachel cannot take over as after-school coordinator, we will need to vote with a quorum and at least 11 non-Board members on a stipend for the secretary (if Hannah agrees).
