Read-a-Thon

Went really well! The cost was \$499 and 15% of all proceeds. Raised over \$10,000! You can still fundraise until the 10th (some parents/family donates after the event is over and a total # of pages read are known). Top readers for each class each week get Craft donuts. A total of 119 of 292 students (40% of school) entered the Read-a-thon. Eighteen kids raised over \$200 "Superstars". Average raised per kid was \$123.

Prizes: delivery has been going smoothly. Melanie is going through the list and preparing the prizes and giving them to the teachers who are then giving the prizes to the kids during class.

K-3 and 4-6 Grand Prizes to \$25 gift card to bookstores There was a tie in the 4-6 so PTC will buy a third gift card.

Kids who read 1,000+ minutes get schwag bags; Melanie will come into the school and get the kids their prizes.

Winter Event

1/25 6-10p. Got a hold of the chef John (from Real Burger) who will be catering. Italian with vegetarian options. We are at 27 items and we are looking for more donations (particularly bottles of wine). Bar is getting taken care of. Carrie working on setting up a sliding scale option (min. would be \$20, which is the cost). Children's Museum will be taking care of our kids! (\$20/per family). Carrie working on getting this all on the website. Melanie will make a flyer to include in kids' folders. We will need volunteers for set up and clean up as well as cashiering. Lots of discussion about the logistics of the set up, clean up, auction, donations, wine pulls, entertainment.

PTC will think more on how to support all departments this year but we will add an actual line item for next year's budget. It would be nice to tie these financial supports to the profits from the Read-a-Thon and let parents know how the money is spent!
